Weavers and Oliver Barrett Trustees of Wash Creek Academy of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargain sold and Released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Trustees in Trust for the use of said Academy a lot supposed to contain Three Acres more or less said Academy Beginning on a Post oak on the upper side of the road running near East direction 145 steps to a post oak on the lower side of the road thence near a North direction 72 steps to a poplar at the edge of the old mill thence near a West direction 145 steps to a Stake in the old mill thence near a South direction 72 steps to the beginning and also the privilege of water from the spring for the use of said Academy Together with all and singular the rights members tenements and appurtenances to the said premises being or in anywise incident or appertaining unto all the above named privileges
