Released and by these presents do grant, Bargain sell and release unto the said
Trustees in Trust for the use of said Academy a Lot supposed to contain Three
Acres round said Academy Beginning on a Red Oak on the upper side of the road
running near East direction 145 steps to a post oak on the lower side of the road there
near a North direction 72 steps to a popular at the edge of the old field fence near a
West direction 145 steps to a Stake in the old field fence near a South direction
72 steps to the beginning and also the privilege of water from the spring for the use
of said Academy. Together with all and singular the rights, members, instruments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining with
all the above named privileges.
