Know all men by these presents that Squire Morgan of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Josiah Kilgore all that Tract or parcel of Land containing One Hundred and eight One Acre Situated in Greenwell District South Carolina on Enore River and Buck Horn Creek which Land was conveyed to him by John and Patience Myers Together with all and singular the rights members hereunto and appurtenances to the said premises Relinquishing and any wise incident or appurtenance To have and to hold all and singular the said premises with the Appurtenances unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Admrs to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof

Cotwell of Mealey District and State aforesaid That we have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell release and relinquish unto the said James A. Cotwell all that Tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville on both sides of the Duncombe Road known as the Gilreath place which Land was sold as the property of J. B. P. Hammett by Wm M. Goodlett then Sheriff of Greenville District which includes all the land within the bounds of the following courses and distances except Nine Acres lying immediately in the South end between the Duncombe Road and the Road to Greenville C. H. which will more fully appear by reference to a deed by J. B. P. Hammett to Heyder and John Heyder both Brockman Beginning as represented by Plak attached to the Grant on a Stake corner 3x on Styles line and running N 58 E 72.10 by a pine stump to a small Blk Oak 3x old marks on Waresworth Original line Thence N 56 W 109.50 running close above point
