 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elizabeth Sloan all that tract or
 parcel of Land containing One hundred and twelve acres more or less Situated in the State and District
 aforesaid on the South Fork of Rocky Creek waters of Enore River. Beginning on a Gum on
 said Creek running Thence N 18 E 36.50 to a Stake on Abner Walker line Thence N 24 W
 11.75 to the oak Thence on John Walker line and John Walker line S 82 W 58 to a small
 Hickory on said Creek Thence down said creek to a black Gum Thence S 48 E 14 to a Poplar
 Thence S 89 E to white oak on said creek Thence down said creek to the beginning

Together with all and singular the rights Membrs Tenements and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Elizabeth Sloan her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs and Executors, administrators, heirs and assigns defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Elizabeth Sloan her heirs and assigns against myself my
 heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof
