Bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto  
the said E. F. Bush All That piece parcel and Tract of Land Situated and being  
in the District of said or a branch of Hickland Creek Containing Seven Acres more  
or less Bounded by Lands of C. S. Irvin and the said E. F. Bush and having such  
forms houses and buildings as are set forth in a plat thereof made by W. P. McRae  
U. S. and certified 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1847 The said Land having been bargained sold and  
delivered by the said Edward Craft to the said E. F. Bush and conveyed by a deed  
bearing date 4<sup>th</sup> March 1847 having but one nitrope and being therein defective this  
deed is executed to remedy said defect

So far with all and singular the Rights Members  
Heir dittaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before  
mentioned unto the said E. F. Bush his heirs and Assigns forever And I do hereby  
bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend  
all and singular the said Premises unto the said E. F. Bush his Heirs and Assigns  
against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming a  
claim the same or any part thereof
