son Erwin Green and for other good purposes of the State and District above mentioned  
have Green Granted and released and by these presents do give, Grant and Release  
unto the said Erwin Green a certain Tract or plantation of Land lying on both sides  
of Marrowbone Creek, waters of Enoree River a part of a tract granted to George  
Russell the fourteenth day of February One Thousand Seven hundred and ninety  
five containing five acres more or less Beginning on a Stone 3 from Thence N  
82<sup>o</sup> W 1.90 chains to Pine 3 from Thence N 52<sup>o</sup> W by 44 chains to a Hickory 3 from  
Thence N 78<sup>o</sup> W 4.44 chains to a Chestnut 3 from Thence S 34<sup>o</sup> W 2.4 chain to a Hick  
oak 3 from Thence S 49<sup>o</sup> E 11.14 to a Somwood 3 from Thence N 49<sup>o</sup> E 6.00 to the begin  
ning Rock Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments  
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid mentioned  
unto the said Erwin Green his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned  
premises unto the said Erwin Green his heirs and assigns against myself and  
my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming a  
to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this the fifth day  
December in the year of New York One Thousand eight hundred and forty nine and  
in the County of the first of American Independence
