 Stike a colored man a part of it conveyed while Caleb Green was his Guardian
 and the other part after Richard Ross became his Guardian and then by the said James
 Stike a his Guardian to the said George Stokes containing Twenty Nine Acres
 Beginning at a Poplar on the bank of said branch running S 36 E 52.55 ch to a
 Stone on Jesse Hawkins line Thence S 88 3/4 E. 7.55 ch to a Stone Thence N
 62 W 24 3/4 ch to a Red oak 37 Thence N 2 W 28.25 ch to a Maple 37 Thence
 up the meanders of the branch to the beginning Together with all and singu-
 lar the Rights, Mentions, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
