Eight hundred and fifty between John Watson Ordinary of the District aforesaid and David Hooke of the same State and District Whereas a writ of Summons to divide a well a certain Tract of Land hereinafter described of the State of Patsy Potts of said district deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District and upon the return thereof the Judges of said Court did determine that the said Land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of twelve months Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said Land for sale on the first Monday in May in the year above mentioned And whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said Land when the said David Hooke was the last and highest bidder to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of Seven hundred and thirty five dollars

Now this Indenture Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and thirty five dollars to me paid and secured to be paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said David Hooke and his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land situated in said District on Maple creek of Kedy River containing Two hundred and Sixteen Acres more or less adjoining Lands of Anderson Dear Barnette Smith and John Fowler Together with the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the estate right, title, interest claim or demand which the said Patsy Potts deceased at the time of her death had in or to the same To have and to hold the said tract of Land together with all
