 Show all men by these presents. That I, Thomas M. Cox of Greenville District in the aforesaid State

in consideration of Five Thousand Dollars to me paid by the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company an Incorporated Company in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company all that piece or parcel of Land which I am now living situated, lying and being in the District of Greenville about one half of a mile from the village of Greenville between the Augusta and Pendleton Roads, commencing at a Stake 34 on the Pendleton Road three Oaks corner and running thence with the said Road to Girdley corner (with the exception of one acre next to Girdley Land, which I do not sell, and which fronts the Pendleton Road as Girdley Land does) thence bounded by Girdley and Land of Oech Tideman bought of John Walker and myself to the Augusta Road thence with the said Road to beam Land, containing unto the aforesaid now or late being all the lands particularly described in the deed of Mechanism to myself (except the acre above reserved) acres sold off to Mr Tideman
