feet to a Stake Thence N 74° W Five Hundred feet to a Stake Thence S 14° E  
One Hundred and ninety four feet to a Stake in Rowne Street Thence S 74° E  
One Hundred feet to the beginning being the Lot of Land purchased of Charles  
J Roberts by deed bearing date the Thirtieth day of September A.D. 1849 and  
recorded in Register Meane and Conroy and Deeds 2 page 333.

Together with all and singular the Rights Members and  
Tenants and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident  
appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
