Wilson all that Tract of Land containing by survey made the 28th Oct 1837 by John C. Neely Esq. 181 acres of Land situated in said District on Cowee River and Duck Head Creek bounded by David Clay & Taylor Thomas Smith James Wood and Wm. Gribble Land in March 1848 beginning at a small P 037 W 75 E 1250 in a Stake in the middle two paces Hutherford Road 20 chs to a rock 3x W 36 44 bgs to a Sp. Line 3x W 3 22 114 e P 0 of the Star 3x A 15 11 16 Sp. Line 3x W 39 6 13 to a Stake 3x W 40 E 1250 to a Pinesum 3x at the head of a branch then down the meander of said branch 14 chs to a Stake on the old Program line then on said line W 8 11 2 6 4 to a stone 3x W 16 11 13 to a Poplar 3x A 30 11 29 to a Bogard Stake 3x S 33 50 to a Poplar 3x S 10 11 33 to a stone 3x S 31 6 38 to a P 038 Then S and on 8 6 4 0 to the beginning and half acre including the spring together with all and singular in tract the rights immovable hereditaments and appurtenances to the said property belonging and in anywise incident or appertaining</p>
