 singular the Personal and Real Estate of the said Robert W. Goodlett deceased  
 consisting of one Tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in Greenville  
 District South Carolina on North Saluda River containing Seventy Acres  
 more or less adjoining Lands of Richard Goodlett James Goodlett and Captain  
 M. D. Brock and having the following lines, marks and boundaries according
