Know all men by these presents that I Francis H. McLeod of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina in consideration of the thousand dollars and upwards to me paid by Robert Douglass of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted all that he hath sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Robert Douglass all that piece of land containing twenty two (22) acres more or less Situated lying and being within the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville Greenville District in the said State and abutting the northern boundary of the same having the following dimensions and boundaries, Beginning at a Stake in the middle of the old Spartanburgh Road there about my residence and running thence 105 ft N 66 E along a Stake twenty feet wide to a Stake of Stone with the lines of the Greenville Academy Land W 15 E S 80 W 12 E 3 62 ft Stone S 80 W 10 E S 13 to a Stake formerly a Person now at the Jim Ward Granite Stone thence S 80 E 10 S 1 branch to a Stake S 70 E 10 S 1 branch to a Stake in the middle of the old Spartanburgh Road, and thence along the middle of said Road to the Stake thence beginning together with all and singular the Rights Members Headements and Immeubles appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident thereto pertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Douglass and his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself Francis H. McLeod my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and give defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert Douglass and his heirs and assigns so long as against my self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming thereto to claim the same or any part thereof.
