The sum of Two hundred and five dollars to me paid by David McCallough
 of the said State and District aforesaid have granted, bargain sold and conveyed
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said David
 McCallough a tract of land lying in the State and District aforesaid
 westerly of Reddy Fork of the Reddy River containing One hundred (100) acres
 or less being a tract of Land said Smith bought of Wilson Tollison in
 the year 1838 and when said Smith formerly lived, beginning on a Stake
 37 on the original line running thence N 20 W 43 to a Stake 37 bounded by
 James Reese and Micajah Perry Lands Thence S 60 W 26 to a Stake 37
 bounding on Micajah Lands Thence S 20 E 14 50 to a Stake 37 Thence S 20
 W 13 to a point 37 bounded by Amos Estkey Land Thence East 37 50 to the
 beginning bounded by Wilson Tollison Lands

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
 have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said
 David McCallough his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and favor defend all and
 singular the premises above mentioned unto the said David McCallough his heirs
 and assigns forever against myself and my heirs and against every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any thereof
