I Henry Arthur do hereby sell and release and confirm unto the said Henry Arthur and his assigns all that Tract of Land lying about three miles from Town of Henderson & adjoining Lands of Hardy McBees & Saech and that containing about One hundred and Fifty acres upon which are Standing Saw Mill and Grist Mill Together with all and Singular the Building improvements and all the rights, franchises, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

To have and to hold the said tract of Land hereditaments and franchises, hereby granted or mentioned or intended so to be with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Arthur his heirs and assigns to the only purpose now in view of the said Henry Arthur his heirs and assigns forever. Provided always nevertheless that of the said Thos S Arthur and W H Campbell their heirs executors or administrators shall do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Henry Arthur his executors and Administrators or assigns the sum of Five Thousand Dollars as before mentioned and appurtenant with lawful just interest for the same according to the condition of the said obligation without any fraud, defalcation or abatement to be made of any thing given or in respect of any Taxes charges or assessments whatsoever from and from thenceforth as well his present indutry and the estate hereby granted as the said recited obligation shall cease determine and become absolutely null and void to all intents and purposes any thing further before contained to the contrary in any writing heretofore made.
