and released unto the said Young Children their heirs and assigns a certain tract
parcel of Land Situated in Greenwich District and State of said State on a branch
of the main Mill creek north of South Patrick River beginning on a
line of 37 Three East five chains to a Stake on Spaulding line Thence with
line North 10 ch to a Stake 37 Three with line N 27 W 15 ch
Stake Thence the beginning containing Twenty Five acres and two Rods
the same more or less, it being a tract devised by John Colman to John Hays
and we truly warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said Young
Children their heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and assigns and against
every other person lawfully claiming the same
