in and by the said recited obligation and constituted thereof relation being
with had now fully appear

Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said

Lewis W Pickens as well for and consideration of the aforesaid debt or sum
of Seventy five dollars and for the better securing the payment thereof
to the said Joseph Harrison George Clayton and John Parrie in
charge of the said recited obligation as for the further sum of one
hundred and fifty dollars by the said Joseph Harrison George Clayton and
John Parrie at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt
hereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained, sold, released and
conveyed and by these presents doth bargain, sell, release and con-
vey unto the said Joseph Harrison George Clayton and John
Parrie the following named property To Wit, of Beauvoir, 1 Leaf
of 2 small pine tables & chairs 1 small Beauvoir with a stand
and some horses one cow and calf 2 iron feather beds, Bedsteads,
bedding, Paroled mouthpieces that if the said Lewis W Pickens
shall and do will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Joseph Harrison, George Clayton and John Parrie the aforesaid debt
or sum of Seventy five dollars on the day and time herein before men-
tioned according to the condition of the said recited obligation without
any further delay than and from thenceforth as well this
indenture and the Goods and chattels sold as the said recited obligation
shall cease determine and become absolutely null and void to all
intent and purport any thing herein before contained to the contrary
in any wise notwithstanding
