Hightower and adm^r. et al And the cause being at issue before the Honourable Court came on to be heard at some Term when the said Court after full hearing of and mature deliberation in the premises did order Adjudge and Direct that the said several Tracts of Land in the above Bill mentioned should be sold at public Auction by the Commissioners of the said Court on or on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their official Order as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear And in the said J. P. Butler as Commissioner of the said Court after having been duly advised the said Tracts of Land for sale by public vendue on the said sixth day of October first above mentioned did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Tracts of Land M. D. Colson deeded unto the said Rebecca Hightower for the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and fifty dollars being at that time the highest bid for the same Wherefore this the said Witnesses that the said J. P. Butler as Commissioner of the said Court in due and by virtue of his office here and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand five hundred dollars and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand five hundred dollars paid him by the said Rebecca Hightower the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged. hath granted that
