acres the same more or less Situate in Greenville District and lying on both sides of a stream  
Marrowbone Creek waters of Enore River it being a part of a Tract Granted to the Revd Mr  
Russell Beginning at a Sennwood Thence N 80 E 5.58 ch to a pine tree Thence N 15 E  
67 E 3.6ch to a Spanish Oak 3x Thence S 43 E 4.20 ch to a W 0 3x on Thence S 90 E  
E. 8.3 ch to a Red Oak 3x Thence N 84 W 13.00 ch to a pine tree Thence S 49 W 16.00 or Thence E  
to the beginning Sennwood

Together with all and singular the rights mervlous chattels  
and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Alridge Green and I do truly bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises  
above mentioned unto the said Alridge Green his heirs and assigns forever against all  
myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
to claim the same or any part thereof
