Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Tenements and appurtenances to the said property belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same and to hold all and singular the property before mentioned unto the said Hough Bishop his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns for ever and to have and to hold the same in fee simple absolute and to have and to hold the same Hough Bishop his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, saving however to the said Sarah Ann Richards her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns all and singular the said property unto the said Hough Bishop his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
