 of Little Rocky Creek beginning on a stake at the School House branch  
 and running N 75 E 30 to a red oak 34 then on David Vaughan's Land N 12 E  
 40 31.60 to a Cypress 34 then on David Smith's Land S 75 W 46.50 to a red oak  
 34 then on Andrew Jones Land S 17 1/2 E 24.80 to a White Oak 34 then S 63 E  
 7.70 to a White Oak 34 then on Andrew Harkin's Land S 31 E 22.05 on up the  
 School House branch to the beginning corner

Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, tenements  
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular before mentioned  
 the said Minister King his heirs and assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and assigns  
 against and against every person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
