 of Five Thousand dollars to me paid by Alexander Watson of Greenville District
 in the State of South Carolina. have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these
 presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Watson
 all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in Greenville
 District and State of South Carolina beginning at a Spick Oak bush and running
 thence S 45° W 33 chs to a Stake on the S 74° Thence N 32° W 1.25 to a Stake Thence
 N 35° W 24.25 to a Stake on the old road Thence along the old road S 21° E 7.25 to
 a Stake Thence due East 34 chs crossing a branch to a Stake Thence S 23° E
 10 chs to a Spick Oak Thence N 45° E 33 chs to a Stake Thence N 25° W 41 chs
 to the beginning corner and containing Two hundred and forty four acres
 more or less of Heedy River bounded on the North by Lands of Oscar Gun
 on the East by Lands of Jacob Rhodes lately deceased on the South by lands
 of W. M. Price and on the West by Lands of Henry Bay Stokes being the tract
 of land that was will'd to me by Elisha Gun late of said District and
 with such corners and marks as are represented by a plat of the same here
