This Indenture made the sixth day of  
December in the year of Our Lord One

Thousand four hundred and fifty two between Samuel A. Tammes Esqur. Com  
145<sup>th</sup> Justice of the Honourable Court of Equity of Greenville District at Greenville Comt  
15. 1852. case in the said State of the one part and Parkside Charles of the other part  
20. 11.

Whereas Isaac Charles and Sad Charles did on or about the  
1st day of September in the year of Our Lord One thousand four  
hundred and fifty two exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity of Greenville

in the said State against Elias H. Garrison and Mary Garrison his wife and  
two children and whereby they pray for among other matters a division of the Real  
and Estate whereof the late John Charles deceased did die seized and possessed  
and the cause being set issue before the Honourable Court on to the hands of  
the members on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of November in the year of Our Lord One thousand  
four hundred and fifty two whom the said Court after full hearing thereof and  
after due deliberation in the premises did Ordre Adjudg<sup>r</sup> and decree that the

said Lands should be sold at <sup>public</sup> auction by the Commissioners of the said Court  
and the sum so to be raised for the purposes mentioned in the said Order as by  
the same directed in the Regality of the said Court will appear And that the said

Samuel H. Tammes an Commissioner of the said Court after having duly adju-  
dicated the said lands should be sold at public auction by the Commissioners  
of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said Order

and expenses thereon to be paid by public on or before the sixth day of December  
the year of our Lord one thousand four hundred and fifty two and this day of

November and according to the custom of auction sell and dispose of the said  
lands herein described unto the said Parkside Charles for the sum of twenty two  
hundred and five dollars being all that price the high and low bid for the same
