Together with all and singular the Right Honorable  
and undoubted opportunities to the said premises belonging or in  
anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs Mary Penrett the Executrix Administratrix, her executors, successors and the said W W Blacke as hereby being my will my heirs, Executrix and Administratrix to remain and forever definite and undivided the said premises unto the said Mrs Mary Penrett and assign from and against myself my heirs Executrix, Administratrix and assigns lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

I binded always hereunto let and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that of the said W W Blacke his heirs Executrix and Administratrix do and shall hold and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Mrs Mary Penrett the said debt or sum of money aforesaid with the interest thereon if any shall be due according to the true intent and meaning of the said Bond and conditions thereto without the aid of Bargain and Sale shall each determine and be utterly null and void otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue And it is agreed by and between the said parties that W W Blacke shall and may hold enjoy the said premises until defauit of payment shall be made.
