Sullivan of Laurens District and State of South Carolina I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said C. P. Sullivan the following tract to wit one Tract containing Two Hundred and ninety five acres (295) more or less situated in the District and State aforesaid known as my father's land with Reedy River and Reedy fork Creek running through it embracing this junction and bounded on the east side of said Reedy River by land of Wilson Baker and Charles Perry and on the West side of said river by land of John D. Edwin Waco Micajah Perry and others, beginning on the west side of Reedy River at a Maple corner (also W.
