Whereas these presents shall whereas  
said deed was on the 10th day of January  
the year of our Lord 1851, entered in public records  
in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to  
be in hand paid by Benjamin J. Barton and Baylis W. Fleming did grant  
and release unto the said Benjamin J. Barton & Baylis W. Fleming  
a certain plantation tract of land whereon Andrew McGray  
formerly lived lying on the waters of Big Run in the State and District  
aforesaid containing two hundred acres more or less bounded as by reference  
to said deed may appear. Now know all ye that the said Benjamin  
Barton in order to make division and partition of the said tract of land  
between myself and Mariner Fleming the widow of Baylis W. Fleming in  
consideration of a like conveyance this day executed by Mariner Fleming for part  
of the above described tracts have granted, sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mariner Fleming  
all my right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of or into all and singular  
that part of the tract of land above mentioned which lay south of a line beginning  
at Benjamin Colcombe Stone corner running thence S 32 W 7 chs 82 1/2 to Hawkins stake  
the being a tract of land granted to John Russell, also all that lay south of a part of a tract  
of land granted to Thomas Barton, beginning on John Russell's land in a rock corner  
running S 80 E 1/2 chs 62 1/2 to a stake to the opposite side of said tract also all the east end of  
tract of land granted to Andrew McGray and Jesse Davis as far as the Thomas  
water grants goes
