 or suffered by me the said Mary Pointt. And lastly that I the said Mary
 Pointt, my executors and administrators and my heirs and all and every
 person or persons can justly claim, or to claim any estate, right, title, true
 or interest of in, or to the said tract of land, and all and singular, then the pre-
 mises herein before mentioned and intended, to be fully granted and released, or any
 part or parcel thereof shall and will, from and at all times hereafter, at the
 reasonable request and proper costs and charges, in the law, of the said
 A. W. Black his executors and administrators heirs and assigns make and
 acknowledge and execute or cause to be executed and procure to be made
 done acknowledge and executed, all and every such further, and other lawful
 and reasonable act and acts, thing and things, conveyance and assurance
 in the said tract of land, and all and singular, other than the premises herein before mentioned and intended to be fully
 granted and released, and every part and parcel, with their and every of
 their appurtenances, to and for the use and behoof of the said A. W. Black and his
 executors, administrators heirs and assigns forever, as by him or them
 or by his or their counsel, learned in the law, shall be reasonably desired or
