and Four Acres more or less Situate lying and being in the District and State  
aforesaid upon the western side of the White House road adjoining lots of  
McClanahan, Elford and others and having the following bound  
aries and buttins beginning at a Chestnut stem; 340 m on the said  
White House road and running thence with said road 24 chains 42 links  
to a rock 3 ft 11 in Ht 36 chains to a White Oak 3 ft 11 in Ht  
346 C 38 chains 23 links to a rock 3 ft 11 in Ht 445 P C 36 chains  
82 links to the beginning said tract having been conveyed to me by William  
Bank
