 I do hereby certify that in the year 1833 I bought a negro girl of my father David Barton by the name of Leda and by the consent of my wife Sally Barton I gave her to my daughter Eliza Barton some time after my Mother Nancy Barton told me that if I would give Rebecca Barton my second daughter a certain negro girl that she had in her possession belonging to one the Indian by the name of Matilda that she would give her up to me I told her I would do so and she complied with her promise and by the consent of my wife Sally Barton I gave Rebecca Matilda.

The above I certify to be a true statement of these two negroes given to my two daughters to the best of my recollection.
