Do get this with all thoughts murders hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant Do have and to have all and singular the premises hereinafter mentioned unto the said William W of His Highness and of His Grace and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William W of His Highness and against myself my heirs and against every person whom I shall lawfully claim in the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this 1st day of February A D 1834 and in the seventy eighth year of American Independence
