

Benjamin Haagood to bear himself and his heirs in due stead so all that
who has agreed to in this agreement I am to protect Barton in the property and
of forth. In consideration whereof it is further agreed between the parties
to this covenant that the said Wilson Barton shall immediately execute
titles to the said Trustee Col. Benjamin Haagood warranting and defending
all the said property above enumerated as being Mrs. Rebecca
Barton from this and his heirs only known or persons claiming through him
in trust for Mrs. Barton and her heirs and assigns forever. It is also agreed
between the parties that Col. Benjamin Haagood is to make and execute
to Col. Wilson Barton immediately a deed warranting and defending
all the property herein mentioned as being Col. Wilson Barton and
covenanting and agreeing that his sister the said Rebecca Barton shall
perform all and every thing therein stipulated to be done on her part.
