deceased lived containing Two hundred and twenty acres binding
lands at present belonging to John Green, Richard Ross, George Ross
Wm. Heaslett and Jonathan Heaslett And we do hereby release and
discharge quit claim of all and singular the said premises unto the said
Thomas J. Shockley his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of
ourselves our heirs and assigns and all other persons lawfully claiming
the same Given under our hands and seals this the fifth day of July
one thousand eight hundred and forty two Miles Southern Seal
