consideration of the sum of eighteen dollars to me in hand paid by
to the said H H Hawkins of the State and District aforesaid do release and
abandon all right title or interest
which I have or can have to or in the tract of land which
on my mother Elizabeth Goodlett now lives which was bequeathed to
her during her lifetime by my brother J M Goodlett and after her
death to be equally divided among the children

Witness my hand and seal this 18th December 1852

The condition of the above bond is such that if the said James M
Goodlett does pay the said H H Hawkins eighteen dollars in
twelve months with interest from date without demand or for the delay
then this obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise remain in
full force and virtue in law

Witness my hand and seal herein the 18th 1852


