fully acknowledged Thaw Dargames, sold & delivered by these presents to my
said daughter all and singular a certain negro girl named Easton about
fifteen years old

Together with all her fixtures & increase of said slave
To have & to hold all and singular the said slave and the increase aforesaid
unto the said S. W Cunningham his executors & administrators forever upon
the special Trust and consideration nevertheless unto and for the general
uses intents and purposes hereafter mentioned and declared and for no other
purpose use or intent whatever that is to say In Trust to permit & suffer the
said Nancy M Pinck to have hold & play employ or have the above named
slave and her increase in any manner she may think proper and during
the term of her natural life & at her death for the use and benefit of such children
children as she may leave her surviving each share & share alike if more
