

issue of her body at her death the said Tolbert C Waddell shall hold the said negro girl Jane in Trust for the said issue of the body of the said Eliza A Smith or any during the term of their natural life or lives.

Fourth In Trust that of the said issue of the body of Eliza A Smith or any of them shall die leaving issue of their body aforesaid that then the said negro girl Jane shall rest in them and their absolutely forever.

Fifth In Trust that if the said Eliza A Smith shall die leaving no issue of her body or if she die leaving issue of body and they die leaving no issue of their body or bodies that then one half of the said negro girl Jane shall rest absolutely in my daughter Martha Ann Waddell and the other half of the said negro girl Jane in Trust for my daughter Mary A Smith upon the same terms trusts and limitations as aforesaid in this deed in relation to Eliza A Smith as is in the failure of issue of body of the said Mary A Smith as above set by with in relation to Eliza A Smith than the half so held in trust for Mary A Smith shall also rest absolutely in the said Martha Ann Waddell and the other half forever.

Sixth in Trust that the issue of the said negro girl Jane shall in all cases follow and be subject to the trusts uses and limitations aforesaid in this deed in relation to the said Jane.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to provide out of my own estate for the support of the said negro Jane until she leaves my possession under the provisions of this deed.
