

issue of her body at her death the said Folbert C Waddell shall hold the said negro girl Jane in Trust for the said issue of the body of the said Eliza St Smith for and during the term of their natural life or lives

Fourth I do Trust that if the said issue of the body of Eliza St Smith or any of them shall die leaving issue of their body or bodies that then the said negro girl Jane shall rest in them and their heirs absolutely forever

Fifth I do Trust that if the said Eliza St Smith shall die leaving no issue of her body or if she die leaving issue of her body and they die leaving no issue of their body or bodies that then one half of the said negro girl Jane shall rest absolutely in my daughter Martha Ann Waddell and her heirs forever and the said Folbert C Waddell shall hold the other half of the said negro girl Jane in Trust for my daughter Mary Estlin upon the same terms trusts and limitations as expressed in this deed in relation to Eliza St Smith and in the failure of issue of body of the said Mary Estlin as above set forth in relation to Eliza St Smith then the half so held in trust for Mary Estlin shall also rest absolutely in the said Martha Ann Waddell and her heirs forever

Sixth I do Trust that the issue of the said negro girl Jane shall in all cases follow and be subject to the trusts uses and limitations expressed in this deed in relation to the said Jane

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to provide out of my own estate for the support of the said negro Jane until she learns my possession under the provisions of this deed
