Whereas we the present that in the
Protestant Episcopal Church of Christ Church Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five dollars to us paid by Peter Gilchrist of
Greenville in said State have Granted, bargained sold released and convey'd
unto us by these presents do hereby Grant, Bargain sell release and convey
unto the said Peter Gilchrist his heirs and assigns forever the freehold
and uninterrupted possession use liberty and privilege of a certain piece
of land or ground situated within the burial grounds attached to the said
church being ten feet in width by thirty feet in length and running
North and South at right angles with the longthwise direction of the said
church inclosing and including the grave of the late Mrs. Peter Gilchrist
which is in the North end of the said plot.

We have and to hold the possession use liberty and
privilege of the said plot of ground freely and exclusively to the said
Peter Gilchrist his heirs and assigns forever for the purposes of burying
white persons therein. Together with trees in grass, grass and rubbish
and from the same and all other necessary privileges for the use and
enjoyment of the same for the purposes indicated in this deed and
we do hereby warrant and defend to the said Peter Gilchrist his
heirs and assigns forever all the rights, privileges and easements
hereby granted against ourselves or successors unto every other person whom
ever lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
