 and in consideration of the sum of seventy Dollars to us paid by Alexander
 Watson in the District and in the State aforesaid, Have granted conveyed sold and
 released and by these presents do Grant convey sell and release unto the said
 Alexander Watson All that Tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being
 in the State and District aforesaid about three and a half miles East of the Town
 of Greensboro adjoining Lands of Mrs Rhodes and Land of said Watson
 on waters of Needy River and bounded as follows by beginning in a Stake
 on Mrs Watsons line running Thence S 60 E 450 Yards to Stake in a line
 Thence S 5 W 24.38 links to Mrs Watsons line of the Gilwath tract Thence
 with said Line S 23 W 15 chains ending branch to small Red oak & X
 Thence N 27 E 8.39 links to small persimmon & Thence North 14.14 links
 to the beginning Containing fourteen Acres less the same more or less
