Where all men by these Presents that we
Mary Shockley (widow of Jesse Shockley dec'd) John
P Shockley, Alfred Gilcath and Maria Gilcath (his wife), Bartholomew Grogan
and Louisa Grogan (his wife) Pleasant Mayfield and Margaret Mayfield (his
wife) heirs at Law of Jesse Shockley deceased of Greenville District in the
State aforesaid do in consideration of the sum of One Thousand &
Sixty five dollars to them paid by Thomas Shockley of Greenville Dis-
trict in the State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released
and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas
Shockley a certain piece parcel or tract of Land lying being and situate
in Greenville District about eight miles from Greenville S.W. on the main road
leading from Greenville C.W. to Spartanburg and on the waters of Enore
River being the said Land whereon the late Jesse Shockley dec'd resided
the same originally conveyed to the said Shockley in two tracts The whole
containing Two Hundred and twenty acres (more or less) The amount specific
being the amount the said Tract of Land sold by the said Thomas
Shockley is entitled to one share in his own name and also entitled to one
share in the name of Miles Southern and Mahala Southern (his wife) as assignee
of Southern & wife as heirs at Law of the said Jesse Shockley deceased
The above conveyed land has the following courses and distances Beg-
inning on Richard Ross' land running Thence N. 47 E 45 ch 32 to
a post or stake (down) now a stake Thence N. 45 W 48 ch 18 to a stake
Thence S 47 W 22 ch 66 to a stake Thence N 47 E 6 ch to a stake Thence
S 47 W 22 ch 66 to a stake Thence S 43 E 51 ch to a stake

In the above conveyance we reserve one acre of said land
as a family burying ground being one acre immediately around where
Jesse Shockley deceased is now interred

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hered-
itaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Shockley his
Heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs
Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said Premises unto the said Thomas Shockley his Heirs and assigns of
law and our Heirs and assigns against any person or persons whatsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
