This Indenture made in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five between Johnson Dams of the State of North Carolina Henderson County and William Metcalf of the State of North Carolina Northampton County Witnesseth that the said Johnson Dams for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to him in hand paid the said Metcalf who of him of good legal age and sole owner and conveyed and conveyed and by these presents do Grant bargain sell unto the said William Metcalf the several pieces or parcels of land lying in the State of North Carolina Greenville District containing forty acres more or less beginning on a white oak running with the branch line a conditional line made by Johnson Dams the bearing to another conditional line made by John Pearson and Winton Whalley then that line on to old original line then down Brushy Cuts to conditional corner on a white oak I being myself my heirs and assigns forever
