Greeting Sir now in that in consideration of your integrity and still full power to make given to you or any two or more of you to take the probate or the execution of the said and various documents set forth upon Simeon Seale to Washington Taylor dated the Twenty eighth day of June one thousand eight hundred and forty four for this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribers hereto to the said witness to appear before you and have and having administered to him as you are lawfully authorized to do an oath or solemn affirmation according to the form of this instrument that no affidavit is true you shall take under his hands an affidavit that he was personally present and saw Simeon Seale sign seal and affix the date hereunder for the uses and purposes and intents therein expressed and that he were the other subscriber thereto sign their names thereto as witness of the due execution which affidavit an authenticated under your hands and seals you shall annex to this Writ

Full power is also given you or any two or more of you to take the resumption of Simeon Seale wife of Simeon Seale of Talbot County in the State of Alabama of his house in the premises described in the deed hereunto annexed or from Simeon Seale to Washington Taylor dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of one thousand eight hundred and fifty four conveying a tract of land situate in Greenville District of the State of South Carolina as described in said deed for this purpose you will cause the said Mary Seale to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from all other persons and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons herein mentioned release and forgive owing unto Washington Taylor his heirs and assigns all his interest and estate and also all through his and all his heirs of or and to all and singular the premises described and conveyed in the deed aforesaid then you shall take under his hands a certificate of her resumption as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon oaths made and affirmed as aforesaid which certificate authenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this Writ

This having certified under your hands and seals the due execution of this Writ and verified the same by the oath of one of you before some magistrate who is authorised by the laws of your state to administer an oath and whose official signature may be properly authentication. You shall carefully return this Writ together with your proceedings thereon to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville District in the State first aforesaid to be duly recorded therein fail not.
