tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & seventy eight  
Acres in the same more or less Situate lying and being in the  
State & District aforesaid on the head waters of Middle Tyger  
beginning on a Spanish Oak Thence S 57° E 20.00 to a stake  
thence N 3° E 35.50 to a dogwood Thence S 78° W 11.75 to a chestnut  
Thence S 44° W 17.11 to a chestnut Thence N 75° W 9. to a Hickory  
Thence a straight line to a Gum Thence S 65° W 8.40 to a pine Thence  
Thence a straight line to a pine Thence S 86° 43.00 to a Spanish Oak  
at the beginning It being part of a tract of land granted to  
Leobis Pitman
