Know all men to these presents
That we Sarah Master, widow and
heir of the late Reuben Master deceased of said state and district
and his sons John B Master, Thomas H Master and William
Master, and his son in law John Goode, and his wife
Lucy Goode, for and in consideration of the sum of certain
dollars to us in hand paid the receipt of which
we hereby acknowledge, have remitted, released and quit
claimed and by these presents do remise, release and quit
claim unto William Wheeler (last a son in law of Reuben
Master deceased) all our right, title, claim, interest & demand
in & to a certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying
in the said state and district on the waters of Armstrongs
creek and red river known as the late residence of Reuben
Master deceased, containing five hundred acres more
or less, adjoining lands of William Choie, James West, George
Evans, Martin Hunt &c and others; with all the rights &
incumbrances thereto appertaining. To have and to hold
the same unto the said William Wheeler his heirs &
assigns forever. And we do covenant with the said Willi-
am Wheeler his heirs and assigns forever that we
are lawfully seized in fee of the said premises that we have
a right to sell and convey the same & that we will warrant
and defend the same against all persons whatsoever, claim-
ing through or under us. In testimony whereof we have here
unto set our hands and seals this the 4th day of April A.D.
1850.
