This indenture, made the Twentieth

day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four between Gower, Cox and Gower, of the one part and Jordan P Poole of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said Jordan P Poole is indebted to the said Gower, Cox & Gower in the sum of Two thousand and Five Hundred dollars & notes and is real due and payable as follows. First Five notes, of Five Hundred dollars due first of January 1855. second note due and payable 1st of January 1856 with interest from 1st of Jan 1855. Third note payable and due 1st of Jan 1857 with interest from first of Jan 1855, as reference to said notes will appear.

Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Jordan P Poole for and in consideration of the notes aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to the said Jordan P Poole by the said Gower, Cox & Gower in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, do grant bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said Gower, Cox and Gower and to their heirs and assigns forever, all that piece parcel or lot of land situated in the corporate limits of the town of Greenville designated in the site plan of the village as No 18 near the Rocky Spring, beginning on
