of South Carolina To all whom these  
present shall come  
I W H Roberts of Greenville District in the State  
aforesaid, send Greeting. Whereas I W H Roberts have procured on my  
friend William Roberts to endorse my note to Jeremiah Phillips for the  
sum of one thousand Dollars included in two notes, The first note of five  
hundred dollars due December the 28<sup>th</sup> 1855. The 2<sup>d</sup> note of five hundred due  
the 28<sup>th</sup> December 1856 and for the payment of which the said William Rob-  
erts is liable as endorser or security as in and of the said notes Relation thousands  
being half doth more July <sup>11</sup> appear. Now know ye that I the said W H Roberts  
for the better securing the payment of the said sum above mentioned  
unto the said Jeremiah Phillips and to save harmless my security, his Ex-  
ecutors, Administrators or assigns together with lawful interest for the same  
have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, etc  
and deliver unto the said William Roberts the following negro slaves.  
(Four in number) viz, one negro woman Mary 31 years old and her two  
children, John 7 years old and Matilda 7 months old and Jimmy a  
stoman about 35 years old. To have and to hold the said negro  
slaves, above mentioned and set forth unto the said William Roberts  
his executors, administrators and assigns forever, Provided always  
nevertheless that if the said W H Roberts his Executors, administrators  
shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Je-  
remiah Phillips and save harmless his security and endorser, his certain  
attorney executors, administrators and assigns the full and just sum above  
mentioned according to the true intent and meaning of the note ento-  
red aforesaid and of these presents, then this deed of bargain and sale  
and all and every clause article and thing therein contained shall cease  
determine and be utterly void and of none effect anything herein contained  
to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.

And it is hereby declared by and between the parties and the  
said W H Roberts for his Executors, Administrators and assigns with  
consent promise and agree to pay and with the said William Roberts his  
Executors, administrators and assigns by these presents that if default shall  
be happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum above men-  
tioned according to the true intent and meaning of the said note  
endorsed to Jeremiah Phillips, that then and in such case it shall
