Callaway all that piece, parcel and tract of land containing ... and ... and sixty eight acres more or less situated in Guilford District and state aforesaid on both sides of Panther's Fork of Muske Creek, waters of Egger river, adjoining lands of John Germany, Chancy et al, Clayton Swannick, William Lynnh and others, and having the following lines boundaries and bearings, viz, beginning at a rock E. (formerly a white oak) and running thence S 21 E 37, 80 to a Rock E. (formerly a Spanish Oak) thence S 32 E 35, 40 to a Red Oak E. C. N. thence S 61 E 74, 00 to a stake E. C. N. thence N 44 W 11, 90 to a Red Oak Stump E. C. N. (in a field) thence N 7 E 9, 35 to a stake E. C. N. thence N 19 W 35, 82 to a stake E. C. N. thence N 36 E 26, 45 to a stake E. (formerly Hickory) thence N 44 W 75 to a Rock E. (formerly a White Oak) being the beginning corner the same being part of a tract containing 1820 Acres originally granted to George Calmon the 2^d April A D 1787.
