Know all men by these presents  
that I Williams Tucker of Glennville

District and State aforesaid for and in consideration  
of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Phela  
Henderson of Henderson county in Carolina have granted  
bargained, sold and released and by these presents do  
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Phela Hen-  
derson all and singular the plantation or tract of lands  
whereon I now live the sd Williams Tucker now live, contain-  
ing two hundred years more or less, situated in the State  
and District aforesaid, lying on both sides of the Devils  
fork a branch of the Middle fork of Saluda River, begin-  
ning at an iron corner on the East side of the tract, running  
N 16 W 9 chains to a red oak, thence N 36 W 10.50 to a Dogwood, thence  
N 10 W 14 to a Post Oak, by a angle thence S 82 W 5.7 to a Red Oak  
thence S 48 to a stake on the back line thence to the beginning,  
it being part of a tract of lands granted to Jeremiah  
Nisbit and from him conveyed to John Small, and from  
him to Jonathan Potts and from them to me together with  
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
wise incident, do have and to hold all and singular  
the said premises unto her the said Phela Henderson  
her heirs or assigns forever, against myself, my heirs, Executors  
or administrators or any person or persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
