Know all men by these presents that J W Tinsley of the State and District of aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by A C Bridges of the District and State of aforesaid do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said A C Bridges, a certain tract or parcel of Land containing ninety eight acres be the same more or less, situate and lying in the State and District of aforesaid on a branch of the waters of the North Fork of Saluda River, Beginning on a Black Oak corner on Magniss line, thence a straight line to the head of a branch, thence down said branch to a Maple corner, thence a straight line to stone corner, thence on Tinsley line to a Post-Oak thence on Chisms line to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said A C Bridges his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defende all and singular the said premises unto the said A C Bridges his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
