Wesley W. Wallin at present of Greenville District in the State aforesaid  
for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear toward  
my cousin Elizabeth H. Weston and in order that she may have a support  
free and independent of all debts and obligations of her husband both now  
and forever and also for the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said  
Elizabeth H. Weston upon the delivery of these presents the receipt of which is fully  
acknowledged have given granted alienated and released and confirmed and by  
these presents do give grant alien enfeoff her and confirm unto the said Elizabeth  
H. Weston for the period of her natural life and at her death to her children or  
their legal representatives of any of them he dead for her and their sole and separate  
use free and independent of all debts or obligations of her husband now  
and forever the following property that is to say  
1st. A lot of Stock consisting of one pair of Black Horses, one cow and one  
fine Hog and six pigs

2<sup>d</sup>. One lot of farming utensils viz Two double wagons and harness, two  
shovels and three hoes, three plows and three plow-harness

3<sup>r</sup>. Lot of household furniture viz Three beds and Bedding, one Beacon  
one side Board, one chest of drawers, one dozen chairs, Three Tables

4<sup>t</sup>. One lot of provisions consisting of forty bushels of corn, Five hundred  
bundles of fodder, Three hundred pounds of bacon

5<sup>h</sup>. One tract of land situated in Greenville District in the State of South  
Carolina on the waters of Mountain Creek on a corner of timber beginning  
at a sweet gum on the bank of the creek, running thence S 82° W 7 ch  
150 rods to a small Hickory tree thence N 30° W 4 rods to a chestnut tree on the  
bank of the creek thence down the meanders of the creek to the beginning  
corner containing two and a half acres to the same more or less

6. One other tract of land situated in Greenville District in the State of South  
Carolina adjoining the above tract on waters of Mountain Creek corner  
of timber, beginning on a white oak corner running thence N 36° W 54 ch to  
a post oak corner, running thence S 55° E to a corner S 85° E to a corner at the  
bank S 42° E to a corner at the creek white oak thence S 35° W along  
the creek to a corner N 60° W to a corner S 63° W

Together with all and singular the tenements buildings  
and appurtenances therunto belonging.

To have and to hold to the said Elizabeth H. Weston  
up to the period of her natural life and at her death to her children  
or their legal representatives if any of them be dead for her and their  
sole and separate use free and independent of any debts or obligations  
of her husband both now and forever against me and my heirs and against  
any other person and persons whatsoever lawfully claiming a to claim  
them or any of them and against such shall and will warrant and pursue  
desirous of these presents
