And at the death of the said Harriet Hester in trust that he will hold the same for the sole separate and several use of her children and one eighth part thereof to be held by the said Shockley in trust for and to the sole separate and exclusive use and benefit of Mahala Bradley the wife of Wmerson Bradley for and during the term of her natural life free from any debts liabilities or control of her present or any future husband and at the death of the said Mahala Bradley in trust that he will hold the same for the sole separate and several use of the children And we the said William Doven and Sarah Bradley do hereby warrant and defend forever all and singular the said chattles and premises unto the said Pleasant Shockley upon the terms and trusts aforesaid, against ourselves and our heirs forever

And the said Sarah Bradley do hereby fully entirely and absolutely, disclaim, renounce, release and from relinquish any claim in trust, right or estate of dower, inheritance or distribution in law or equity, of in or to all and singular the present and future Real and Personal estate of the said William Doven to which the said Sarah Bradley might otherwise become entitled by reason of the Marriage aforesaid

And the said Pleasant Shockley doth fully accept and bind himself to carry into execution the various trusts and confidences herein created and repose in him

To all which premises we do hereby mutually bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators
